Extended Care

Extended Care is available on school days both before and after school. Morning Care is open 7:00 to 7:50am and After School Care is open from the end of the school day to 5:30pm.

Daily Rate:

Morning Care \$6.00 After School Care \$18.00

Full Day Care \$24.00 (includes Morning and After School Care)

Half-Day After School Care \$30.00

A yearly non-refundable registration fee is charged for all students attending Extended Care and is billed to your FACTS account.

First Child \$50, Additional Child \$25, Family Maximum \$100

An extended care form will be given to you in your back to school packet. If you are unsure if your child(ren) will attend Extended Care, do not submit the form at this time. Students can be registered for Extended Care at any time during the school year.




Mass
