The Mother & Child Education Center is a non-profit organization which offers hope, support, education and guidance to women who are pregnant and parenting.



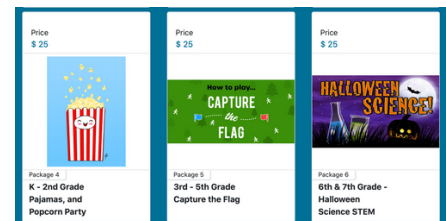
